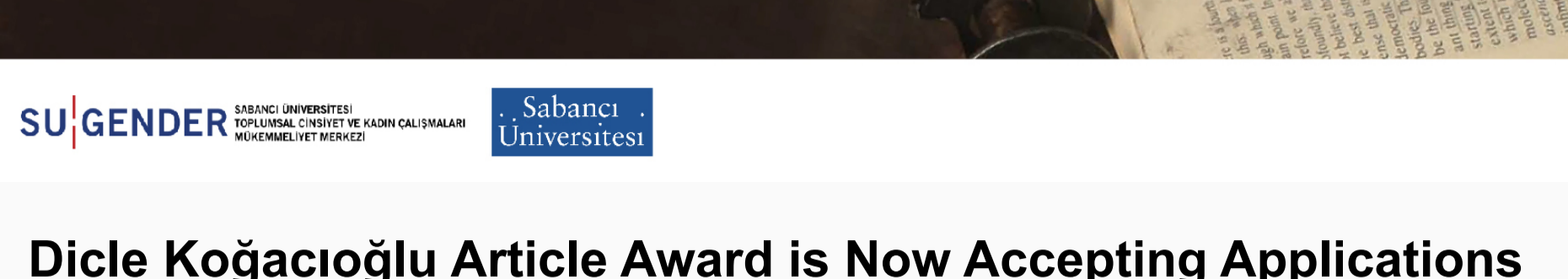

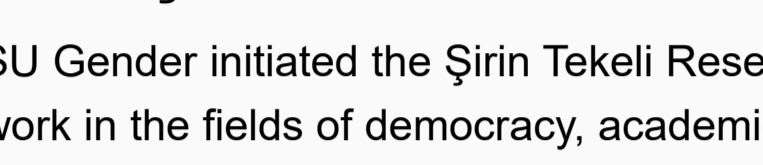

### "Mapping Gender" is Published

*Mapping Gender in the Near East: What's New and What's Ahead in Ottoman and Turkish Women's, Gender, and Sexuality Studies*, edited by Hülya Adak and Richard Wittmann, was published this month by Max Weber Stiftung Bonn. The book consists of contributions from prominent scholars such as Deniz Kandiyoti, Evren Savcı, Marilyn Booth, Irvin Cemil Schick, İpek Hüner Cora, Heike Pantelmann, Efi Kanner, Lerna Ekmekçiöğlü, Laurent Mignon, bringing together groundbreaking collaborations, innovation in theory and research and gender with the intersection of studies of the Ottoman Empire and Turkey from the world's most important universities (a total of 25 universities, centers and libraries) such as MIT, Yale, Oxford, SOAS, Freie Universitaet Berlin, Sorbonne, Sabancı, Koç, Boğaziçi, and American University in Beirut. The book features an article co-authored by Heike Pantelmann and Hülya Adak, titled "Institutional Collaboration Models," discussing the history of the exemplary peer collaboration between SU Gender and Margherita von Brentano Zentrum. İlayda Ece Ova and Nazlı Hazar from SU Gender supported the research and editorial processes of the book.



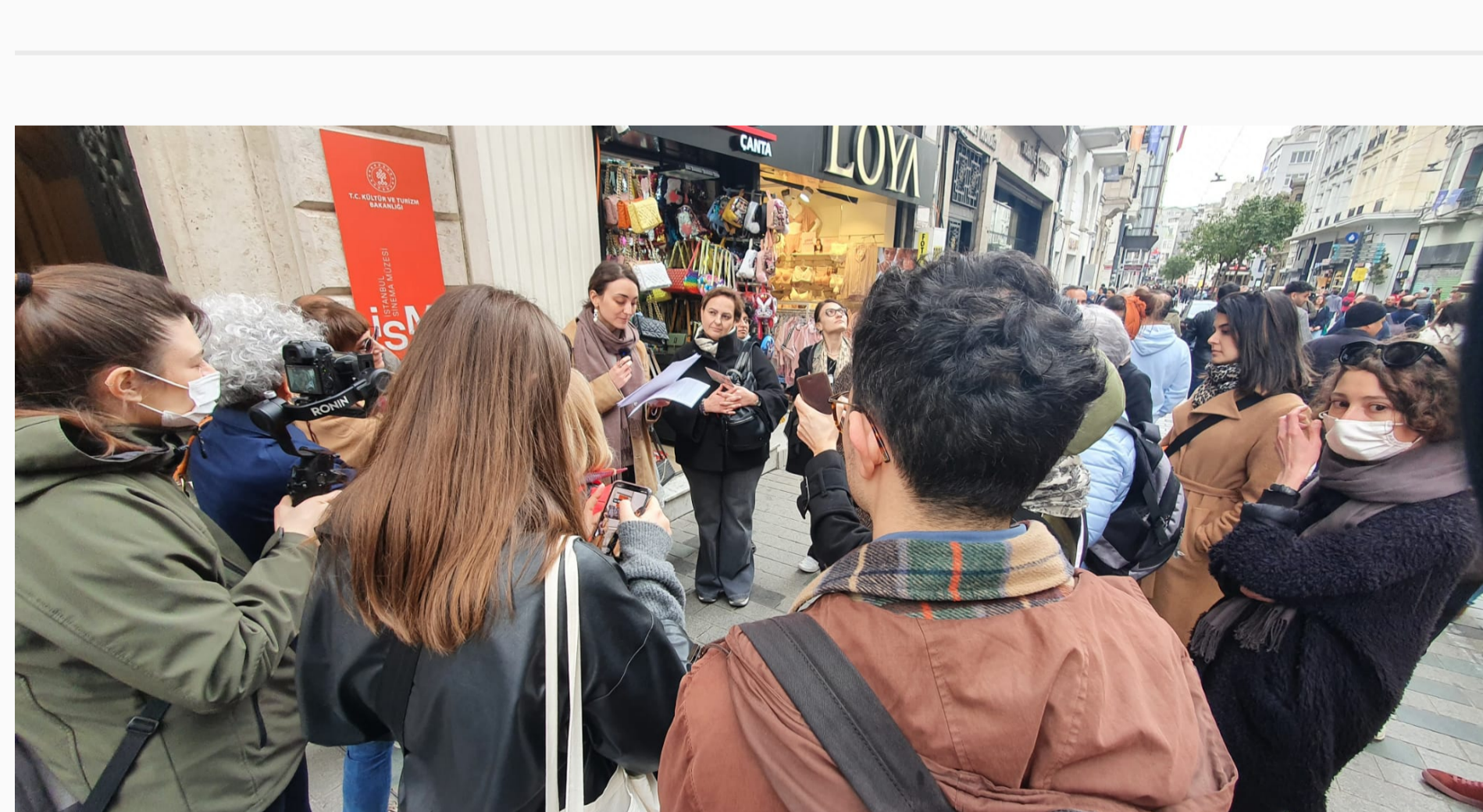
### "Mapping Gender" Book Launch Event

The launch of the book *Mapping Gender in the Near East*, edited by SU Gender Director Hülya Adak and Orient Institut Istanbul der Max Weber Stiftung Director Richard Wittmann, was hosted by the German Consulate General in Istanbul on the evening of April 26th. At the conference in December 2020, researchers from different disciplines had come together to discuss the current status of gender studies carried out in the context of Ottoman and Turkish Studies. During the book launch in the German Consulate General Istanbul, after Consul General Johannes Regenbrecht's welcome speech, editors Hülya Adak and Richard Wittmann delivered dialogic presentations on the book and the writing process, also discussing the future of gender studies and their upcoming projects. Lastly, the play "House of Hundred" was staged by GalataPerform and directed and performed by Yeşim Özsoy. In her presentation of the play, Hülya Adak referred to the "House of Hundred" as a unique example at the intersection of historiography, gender and performance arts.



### "Inclusive Leadership" at TÜAD Research Summit

Hülya Adak was invited to deliver a speech at the biggest Research Summit, which took place on April 6-7, with the participation of faculty members from all MBA programs in the world, consultants, and experts from marketing and the private sector. On the second day of the summit, Hülya Adak delivered her talk on "Inclusive Leadership."



### Walks of Beyoğlu In the Footsteps of Artist Women Continue

We continue our walks of Beyoğlu in the Footsteps of Artist Women both physically and online. Having designed it based on the "I-You-They: A Century of Artist Women" exhibition in Meşher, we first held this walk in March with the collaboration of Meşher Gallery and our Curious Steps program. This month, we met with the participants physically on April 12th and online on April 19th. Our narrators volunteered to share the stories of the women artists who held an important place in Beyoğlu's memory, either by living and working there, and whose stories cannot find a place in mainstream historical narratives. ### What activities did we attend?

- On April 20th, Zeynep Gülrü Göker gave a training titled "Rethinking the Relationship between Language and Gender for an Equitable and Inclusive Institution and Society" to the employees of Reckitt as part of ProGender+. In this seminar- training, Göker discussed the effects of gender on language and the role of language in the construction of gender with examples from daily and corporate life, and shared the steps that can be taken for transformation, and the obstacles that may be encountered along the way.

- On April 5th, Nazlı Hazar from SU Gender's Purple Certificate Program was invited to a talk titled "Open Communication: Gender Equality and Parenting," organized by Açı Schools. After the informational presentation on fundamental concepts of gender, parents and teachers shared their experiences.

- On April 27th, we attended an event hosted by the EBRD (European Bank for Reconstruction and Development), as the Bank announced its strategies for promoting gender equality and equal opportunity. In the first part of the event, the EBRD announced steps to be taken to achieve gender equality. In the panel that followed, a discussion session was held with the participation of panelists from Turkey who received EBRD support and who work in the field of gender equality in the business world.

## What's Next Month?

### The Purple Certificate Program in Çanakkale

With the generous support of EnerjiSA Üretim, we will be holding the Purple Certificate program in schools in Çanakkale for the first time. Further, in collaboration with Sabancı Holding, we will be organizing panels and trainings on Gender Equality, Sustainability and Violence Against Women. The panels in May will feature Hülya Adak, Derya Özet Yalçı and Ayşe GülAltınay. The trainings will be organized by Hülya Adak and Caner Hazar.
